BLACKLINE TRACK LEAGUE

EVENT NOTES

- This is a brand new series, designed, organised and run by volunteers, please be patient if we need to adjust or work out any kinks.
- Strictly no parking under the roofline or near front door.
- This area is required to be clear for emergencies including Ambulance access if needed.
- Nearby food options available (Cafe at Soccer Pavillion)
- Other shops are within a few minutes drive of the velodrome for supplies / lunch
- Working with Children Checks required for any Adult working in the infield in team manager, mechanic, coaching or other roles

Race Scheduling

- The race program is scheduled as full as possible and to assist we need riders to be available for their events
- Races will not be held up for missing teams or participants
- Exit the track as per Commissaire instructions within 2 laps
- Keirin races will be started from fence to assist with tight schedule
- Match sprint races will either be fence start, or rolling start - starter to advise
- U23 and U19s will race and be graded together. Individual tallies will be maintained for each age group and gender and discipline, however team points will be based on grade / gender.

Team Points

- Points will be accumulated with maximum of 2 riders per race from any Blackline Team scoring
- Team Races will have a single team scoring for any Blackline Team
- Grading Races do not score points
- Match Sprint points will be allocated after finals weighted for 3 events
- Adjustments may be made to Team points rules if necessary and will be communicated to all team managers.

BLACKLINE TRACK LEAGUE

EVENT GRADING

Blackline Track League is primarily a teams based event. While there are some team events, the teams element is about gaining as many points as possible to win the overall teams season championship. Teams will require strategic planning and execution to ensure they can win the maximum amount of points. Teams will need to ensure maximum participation across events and all rounds of the season.

The competition consists of athletes both in J19 and U25 and male / female categories. While most races are gender specific, there are some events planned that include mixed gender teams.

In addition, we have introduced a grading system to ensure that all riders have a chance of contributing to their teams success. The points system is weighted to A grade, however teams can only have their best two (2) results counted in each race, therefore B grade races will add valuable points teams overall standings.

The event organisers with commissaire input will participate in the grading process. Riders must participate in a grading event (see details below). Grades may not be equally distributed and will be based on either times or overall positions.

Enduro Event Grading (If required)

- Shortened Scratch Race heats will be used for this event, riders will remain in the grades for all enduro races within this round.

Sprint Grading

- A Flying 200 time will be recorded in each round for all riders in sprint events
- The time will be used for both grading and tie-breaking

TEAMS EVENTS

Teams Events can be in the following formats:

- Single Gender
- Mixed Gender

Teams events are not grade based, and any rider from sprint or endurance disciplines can enter without entering the grading race.

FAQs

Q. What if my team doesn't have enough Sprinters for a team sprint?

A. Use another team member of same gender - eg Endurance

Q. What if there aren't enough riders of my gender in my team at this event?

A. Your Team Manager should liaise with the organisers, and we will co-ordinate with other teams who have additional riders. Points will be split to each Team based on participation proportion.

Note for technical events such as the Madison, where a team member is not capable of entering, the organisers may find a replacement rider where available.

Q. How many teams can we enter in team events?

A. 1 Team minimum, additional teams may be invited when numbers permit

BLACKLINE KEIRIN

- Participants will be mixed across 2 qualifying rounds within their grade
- Finals will determine final finishing order
- Finals will be determined by accumulated points from qualifying rounds
- Start from Fence
- Points for Qualifying rounds

BLACKLINE MATCH SPRINT

- Participants will be graded based on F200 times into 2 grades
- Each grade will have 3 Sprint Rounds, plus top 4 to single final (best of 1)
- Finishing order based on points accumulated through sprint rounds with points allocated as per below
- If there is a tie on points, count back is on F200 time.
- Start from Fence / Rolling Start (Starter to advise)

EVENT SPECIFIC RULES

TEAM RELAY POINTS - ENDURO

- Open event - Sprinters and Enduro
- 40 Laps race, raced by teams of two riders (one male, one female)
- Two sprints contested by each of the team members (Only one racing on track at any time)
- Exchange (Madison / touch) to take place in the exchange window (after 1st sprint and before 15 laps to go)
- Female Rider to start first
- Teams can gain or lose 20 points for one lap (gained / lost) maximum
- Sprint 1 - 25 to go - Points 10/7/5/3/2/1
- Sprint 2 - last lap - Points 10/7/5/3/2/1

TEAM RELAY POINTS - SPRINTERS

- Open event - Sprinters and Enduro
- 18 Laps race, raced by teams of two riders (one male, one female)
- Two sprints contested by each of the team members (Only one racing on track at any time)
- Exchange (Madison / touch) to take place in the exchange window (after 1st sprint and before 8 laps to go)
- Female Rider to start first
- Teams can gain or lose 20 points for one lap (gained / lost) maximum
- Sprint 1 - 10 to go - Points 10/7/5/3/2/1
- Sprint 2 - last lap - Points 10/7/5/3/2/1

QUEBEC PROGRESSIVE POINTS

- 30 Lap race
- Sprint 1 - 24 to go - Points 1st - 1
- Sprint 2 - 16 to go - Points 1st - 2 / 2nd - 1
- Sprint 3 - 8 to go - Points 1st - 3 / 2nd - 2 / 3rd - 1
- Sprint 4 - Last Lap - Points 1st - 5 / 2nd - 3 / 3rd - 2 / 4th - 1

BLACKLINE TRACK LEAGUE

TEAM POINTS

Teams will accumulate points based on competitor placings in events. For individual events, the team will be awarded points from their best two riders only. In Teams events, if your team has entered more than one team, only the best team result will count.
